CHILD CARE FIRST AID

Provide First Aid in an Education and Care Setting is a course that is relevant to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting.



Course Code: HLTAID012

Course Currency Status: Current

VET Prerequisite: No VET prerequisites required

Mode of Delivery: Pre-learning and face to face classroom

Duration: Up to 6 hours of pre-course reading and e-Learning Assessment, plus 5 hours face-to-face training in a classroom environment

Course Content

The Child Care First Aid course will provide students with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Recognise and assess an emergency situation.
- Ensure safety for self, bystanders and casualty.
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for First Aid response.
- Seek assistance from emergency services.
- Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in accordance with the guidelines established by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC).
- Provide First Aid in accordance with established First Aid principles.
- Ensure casualty feels safe, secure and supported.
- Obtain consent from casualty where possible.
- Use available resources and equipment to make the casualty as comfortable as possible.
- Operate First Aid equipment according to manufacturers' instructions.
- Monitor the condition of the casualty and respond in accordance with First Aid principles.
- Accurately convey incident details to emergency services.
- Report details of incident in line with appropriate workplace or site procedures.
- Complete applicable workplace or site documentation, including incident report form.
- Report details of incidents involving infants and children to parents or caregivers.
- Follow appropriate workplace or site procedures to report serious incidents to the regulatory authority.
- Maintain privacy and confidentiality of records and information in line with statutory or organisational policies.
- Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self and other rescuers and seek help when required.
- Contribute to a review of the First Aid response as required.

Course Title: Provide First Aid in an education and care setting

Assessment: Written, practical and scenario-based assessment

Entry Requirement: e-Learning to be completed by 11.59pm AEST the day before scheduled face-to-face training.

Certificate Valid: 36 Months from the date of course completion

Minimum Age Requirement: 14 Years

Certificate Issued

Students who successfully complete the training and assessment requirements will be issued with a PDF Statement of Attainment in *HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation*, *HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support*, *HLTAID011 Provide First Aid* and *HLTAID012 Provide First Aid in an education and care setting*.

Who Can Attend?

This course is for students with existing First Aid experience or for those who are new to First Aid and comfortable learning in a blended delivery setting.

Factor to Consider

Students attending course will be required to demonstrate their ability to perform 2 x 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult and child manikin placed on the floor to meet the performance criteria for assessment.
