



PROVIDE CPR

Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) is a course that teaches students the skills and knowledge to respond to an emergency situation and perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation in line with Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

Mode of Delivery: Pre-Learning and face-to-face classroom

Duration: Up to 2.5 hours of pre-course reading and e-Learning, plus 2 hours face to face training in a classroom environment

Course Content

The Provide CPR course will provide students with skills and knowledge in the following areas:

- Recognise and assess an emergency situation.
- Ensure safety for self, bystanders and casualty.
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR).
- Seek assistance from emergency services.
- Perform CPR in accordance with the ARC guidelines.
- Display respectful behaviour towards casualty.
- Operate an automated external defibrillator (AED) according to manufacturers' instructions.
- Accurately convey incident details to emergency services.
- Report details of incident in line with appropriate workplace or site procedures.
- Maintain privacy and confidentiality of information in line with statutory or organisational policies.
- Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self and other rescuers and seek help when required.
- Contribute to a review of the first aid response as required.

Certificate Issued

Students who successfully complete the training and assessment requirements will be issued with a PDF Statement of Attainment in *HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation* on the same day.

Who Can Attend?

This course is for students with existing First Aid experience or for those who are new to First Aid and comfortable learning in a blended delivery setting.

Factor to Consider

Students attending course will need to demonstrate their ability to perform at least 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult manikin placed on the floor to meet the criteria for assessment.
